The Office of the Ombudsman has responsibility for investigating and resolving complaints of maladministration, public complaints against the police and dealing with freedom of information appeals. In the future the Office will be responsible for overseeing whistleblower and data protection legislation.

The investigators will be responsible for examining complaints from people who feel they have been unfairly treated by the Royal Cayman Islands Police Service. To conduct impartial, independent and thorough examination of allegations of poor police practice, objectively analyse the matters raised by the member of the public as well as the actions of the police, identify the salient issues and make recommendations.

The Senior Police Investigator must possess a university degree or a similar tertiary qualification or equivalent and have at least 10 years' extensive investigative experience and no less than 5 years' experience at a senior management level preferably in the police service.

The **Police Investigator** must possess an **associate degree or equivalent** and have no less than **10 years'** extensive investigative experience

It is essential that applicants have a sound knowledge and recent experience of criminal investigation techniques and practices.
