The Office of the Ombudsman has responsibility for investigating and resolving complaints of maladministration, public complaints against the police and dealing with freedom of information appeals. In the future the Office will be responsible for overseeing whistleblower and data protection legislation.

The remit of the Office of the Ombudsman covers all Government Ministries, Portfolios, Departments and Sections, Statutory Authorities and Government Companies

The Deputy Ombudsman (Complaints) is the head of the Complaints Division which is charged with monitoring the public administration through the examination and investigation of maladministration and public complaints against the police. The Deputy will also be responsible for overseeing the Whistleblower legislation.

S/he will possess a broad understanding and knowledge of public administration including the political and legal systems, and the governance of public bodies.

The post-holder must have:

- a University degree or similar tertiary qualification, preferably in Law or Public Administration.
- proven investigatory, legal and analytical skills exhibited in varying environments over extended periods of time; and
- 10 years' experience working in a government environment and at least 5 years at a senior managerial and in interpreting and implementing legislation is highly desirable.
